Fall 2016 SOAR Course Locations and Parking Info (updated: 08-13-16)

SUNY Potsdam – Campus Layout and Parking: www2.potsdam.edu/campusmap (provides a link to the university's interactive map showing building shapes, names and locations; use tab at top to link to the parking map)

LAYOUT NOTES: SUNY classroom buildings are largely situated in a square, with the Crumb Library sitting in the center of the quad. At each corner of the quad, you will find an open-arched walkway between the buildings. You can "cut through" some buildings to get to the other side; and, in many cases, walk through adjacent buildings. There is one large open gap in the quad: a statue of Minerva stands there, looking across Barrington Drive to the main entrance of the Barrington Student Union (where we will have our fall luncheon at the end of this semester). Opposite to the north-east side of the quad (i.e. across from Kellas, Merritt and Timerman Halls, sits the Crane School of Music, with its own library and classroom buildings - Schuette Hall and Bishop Hall, as well as Hosmer Hall, Snell Music Theater, and new Performing Arts Center (PAC), with its new Proscenium Theatre (and the main box office). Maxcy Hall (sports complex) sits by itself with its own parking areas, just off Outer Main St. You can find the SOAR office in room 382 (on the third floor; just to the left when you exit the elevator) of Van Housen Extension. The University Police is directly below the SOAR office on the first floor.

PARKING NOTES: Please give yourself extra time for parking and walking to your SUNY classrooms. **Parking reminders:** 1) Write your plate # on the permit; 2) Park **ONLY** where visitor parking is permitted; 3) Always display your permit on your rearview mirror when on campus; 4) Your permit is valid through August 31, 2017.

SOAR Course Locations on the SUNY Potsdam Campus (NOTE: an * = a new SOAR location)

Barrington Student Union MPR (second floor, back side). Site of our end-of-semester luncheon (parking info coming later). Use the main entrance (which faces the statue of Minerva); go straight up the staircase (taking the left branch); to second floor; turn right at the corridor; and walk straight back to the **MPR** (multi-purpose room). To use the elevator: from the main entrance, take the right-hand hallway to the restrooms alcove; the elevator is just to the right of the "men's room" door; once upstairs, work your way back to the front of the building and cross over to the other corridor; turn right, then straight to the **MPR**. Restrooms are also near the entrance to the **MPR**.

*Brainerd 205 - Printmaking Studio (second floor). Park in one of the lots 18, 19, 20 or 22 (near Van Housen Extension) or in lot 1 (near the Flagg/Morey entrance to the quad). Walk to Barrington Drive. On the end of Brainard, descend the long white cement handicap ramp. Enter Brainerd and take the stairs up one flight. Enter the corridor. 205 is directly opposite the stairs. Restroom nearby.

Crane: *Bishop C101, B115, and Wakefield Recital Hall (C224): Park in Lot 9 as close as you can to Bishop Hall. Enter the end closest to Outer Main St. C101 is at the far end of the hall (near the Performing Arts Center) in an alcove on the right. To get to B115, when you get to the center of corridor, turn right, pass the elevator using the left side corridor; B115 is several doors down on the left. To get to Wakefield Recital Hall (C224), after entering Bishop, take the staircase on your left to the second floor; C224 is in the center of the corridor; or take the elevator in the (see above) to the second floor: Walk around the staircase - C224 is directly in front of you. (Nice day? Take an alternate path to C224: Park close to Hosmer Hall, walk outside up the left cement ramp; turn left at the top into Bishop; C224 is just beyond the staircase.) Restrooms on the ground level are in the center of the Crane complex down the left and right corridors, past the elevator; on the second floor restrooms are left and right of C224.

Flagg 163 and *203: Park in lot #1 (or #2). Walk to the Flagg/Morey corner of the quad and enter Flagg Hall. To get to Flagg 163, veer a little right and take the half-staircase (or nearby elevator) to the basement level. Walk to the far long corridor, turn left; 163 is two doors down on the right. To get to Flagg 203, after you enter the building, take the elevator or any staircase to the second floor; 203 is the last classroom on the left, before the far staircase down into Satterlee Hall. Restrooms are near the junction with Satterlee.

Kellas 217 (second floor, door to room faces lot #6). Park in lot #2 (or #6 behind the building). Enter at the corner archway door (from lot #6, enter the central back door, turn right to enter Kellas). Take the stairs or elevator (in the Kellas vestibule near the back door) to the second floor; 217 ("distance learning") is around the corner, the first door on the left. NOTE: watch out for the single step when you enter and exit room 217! Restrooms are further down the corridor, adjacent to 217.

Maxcy 104 and Maxcy Dance Studio. Park in lot #30 or #27 (NOT lot #29, the row closest to the building). To get to Room 104 (ground floor): after entering, bear right and go to far end of the corridor and turn left; 104 is the first room on the right. To get to the Dance Studio (on 3rd floor): after entering, bear right; take the first stairs on the left to 3rd floor (or use the elevator at far end of the corridor); as you head down the corridor, the Dance Studio is the first room on the right, overlooking the parking lot. Restrooms - use women's locker room opposite 104 or men's locker rooms near the entrance to the building; or walk past 104, go up the stairs and find regular restooms nearby.

Morey *114 and 117: Park in lot #1 (or #2). Walk to the Flagg/Morey corner of the quad and enter Morey Hall. Follow straight along the corridor (passing by restrooms), turn right at the end, and walk down to Morey 117 - the last room on the right. To get to Morey 114 keep walking straight, passing 117 into the next corridor, where you will find 114 directly in front of you.

Satterlee 225. Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter the quad from the Flagg/Morey corner. Enter Flagg (on the right) and take the nearby staircase to the second floor; walk to the far end of the corridor and down a half-flight of steps into Satterlee, arriving into the history of SUNY Potsdam display area. Walk through the display area to the far side where you can either take the stairs or the elevator to the second floor. Continue down the second floor corridor, almost to the end (note the restrooms as you go by). Room **225** will be on your right, at the end of the last short corridor.

Stowell 211 and Stowell Planetarium. Park in lots #1 or #2. Cross over the quad until you reach the statue of Minerva (opposite Barrington Union). Turn left to enter Stowell Hall. **Stowell 211** is the large tiered classroom on the right. Continue up a few steps and down the corridor to the first staircase and elevator; descend to the basement. The entrance to the **Planetarium** is at the bottom of the stairs. Restrooms are in the middle of each hall.

Timerman 121. Timerman forms a corner arch with Stowell. Park in lot #2; walk thru the first arch, around Merrit Hall and enter the Timerman (on the left) at the archway. Once inside, turn right. **Timerman 121** is the second door on the left. **Alternate path:** Park in lot #6 (back of Kellas), enter the rear door and cross over to opposite corridor, turn left and go almost to the end to **121**. Restrooms are in the middle of the other long corridor.

Other Potsdam Locations:

Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (Mormons), (21 Castle Drive - *just off of Leroy St. at the far end of Castle Dr.)* Drive completely around to park at the back door; you are then only steps away from the Multi-purpose room *(MPR)* on the right. Restrooms are across the hall.

Mayfield Apartments: Community Room, (22 Mayfield Drive - *just off May Road*). The community room is in the one-story office building in the center of the circular drive at the back of the complex. Park only where you see "VISITOR" (*marked on the curb*), or park in the lot beyond the circle. Restroom is adjacent to the room.

Potsdam Civic Center: Community Meeting Room, (2 Park Street). (The room is on the 2nd floor of the new addition at the back of the older Civic Center). Park behind the building complex or in any nearby public parking lot (e.g. find free parking sections across from, and behind, the theater). Do **NOT** park in the IGA lot! Enter at the back corner doorway, using the Police Station entrance; once turn right, go up a half-flight of stairs; turn left and go up another half-flight to the room. (There is a small **elevator** near the stairs. **NOTE:** Close the inner elevator door as well as the outer door to turn on the light inside.). Restrooms are directly below the meeting room.

United Methodist Church: Sanctuary, (26 Main Street). Park behind church (or in the lot off Union St., or across from theater); enter via the **handicap door** on the front, or the side door (by the manse); once inside, go up the half flight, the Sanctuary is on the Union St. side of the church. Restrooms: one beyond the social room, others downstairs.

NON-TOWN LOCATIONS: (NOTE: an * = a new SOAR location)

Glen Meal State Forest: (near Pierrepont): The State Forest is south of Pierrepont on CR 24/50. The access road is on the left ~0.6 miles from the intersection of CR 24 and CR 29. Park on the sides of CR 24 or on the edges of the access road. (NOTE: a map is posted on the location page of the SOAR web site.)

Knapp Station Community Church (3035 CR47). Easiest driving route from Potsdam (*if you don't know the area back roads*): take Hwy 56 north from Potsdam to Norfolk; turn right (*at the liquor store*) onto CR 47; once in Knapp Station, look for the church (on a small rise) on the right (just past where CR 48 "T's" with CR 47)

*St. Lawrence County Power Equipment Museum: (1755 SH 345). Take HWY 310 to Madrid. At the stop sign, turn south-east (away from Madrid) on HWY 345. The museum will be on the right - 115 acres with many buildings and inside and outside equipment on display. Can't miss it!

Canton Free Library: The Paige Room, 8 Park St. (next to the post office). There is un-metered parking along the side of the park nearest the Presbyterian Church, and also further along the sides of Park St. itself: a large parking lot is behind the library (entrance between the library and the post office (or enter via Minor St. Rd., the road between the Village Hall and gas station). Once inside, take the stairs down, turn left, the left again into the Paige Room. Restrooms are opposite the Paige Room.

Partridge Knoll: Multi-Purpose Room, (30 Sullivan Dr.) This is a large retirement complex. Coming from Potsdam on Hwy 11, turn right onto 310 at the first stop light (Stewarts); pass by Judson St. Make a sharp left at the next road; pass by "United Helpers" complex. Take the next right ("Sullivan Dr.), then right again; the MPR is at the left end of the building; park in front or on the left side. From Downtown Canton turn onto Court Street; continue onto State St.; just past the Canton schools, turn left onto Sullivan Dr. Restrooms near the main entrance.

SLCHA (St. Lawrence County Historical Society): **Silas Wright House**, **County Gallery in the Red Barn Addition**, (3 East Main Street) (Rt.11). Governor Wright's white house and picket fence sits across from old town park. The red barn addition, parking and main entrance are at the back of the house. Turn onto Court St. Use Canton Savings and Loan bank entrance to drive and park behind the SLCHA building. There is also free parking in the large lot behind the nearby county building (entrance is from Judson St.). Do <u>not</u> park in the Canton Savings and Loan spaces. Two restrooms near the entrance.

St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES: Conference Room A (40 W. Main St.- on the right, on Rt.68 heading towards Ogdensburg from downtown). Park in the lot next to the building (the entrance to the lot is from Hammond Drive). Enter the building from the front main entrance and walk straight back through the wide open main lobby to Conference Room A. From the parking lot entrance, work your way to the lobby, then to the back and slightly left to Conference Room A. Restrooms in a vestibule off the main lobby.

St. Lawrence University - SLU (Romoda Dr.): (NOTE: * = a new SOAR location)

NOTE: Do <u>NOT</u> park in marked reserved spots for *faculty/staff or visitor* - those all require an SLU pass) To avoid getting a ticket, park only in **lot J** (just beyond the science buildings); **lot D** (behind and on the far side of the sports complex - *no parking pass needed!!*) **NOTE:** entrance to **lots J and D** is off of Park St., or **lot H** next to Vilas Hall (administration) and across from Griffiths Arts Center and the **Noble Center**. **NOTE:** use the formal entrance to SLU from Main St. to get to **lot D**. **NOTE:** *Lot D is often full; but there may handicap spots available in the row facing Griffiths and Noble Center*. The walk from **lot J** is uphill; the walk from **lots D and H** are more level. **NOTE:** Always display your **SOAR parking pass!** (SLU Security knows when we have classes on campus.)

Bewkes 232 and 303. (Second building from J lot with a 1/2 flight of outside stairs facing Park St.) Once inside, go up another 1/2 flight. Bewkes 232 is on the right, two doors down; go up another flight and 303 is a few doors down on the left. Restrooms are by the elevator at the end of the hall.

Carnegie 10 (adjacent to non-tower end of chapel). Once inside descend to the basement theater / lecture hall which is **Carnegie 10**. Restrooms are near the theater.

*Johnson 303 (Analytical Chemistry); (the 3rd building from Lot J); follow the circular drive and enter the 2nd wing (under the archway). Take the elevator to the third floor. 303 is the 3rd and 4th doors down on the right. Restrooms are at the far end of the corridor, near the water fountain.

*Noble Center 108 (Newell Center for Arts Technology). Park in lot H, if you can. If not walk diagonally from lots J and D. to Noble Center (sits behind the new white dorm on the grassy quad). Enter at the "Noble Center" sign. 108 is opposite the main desk. Restrooms are in the hallway that leads to the theater.

*Piskor 10 (Red brick building across from the Book Store: NOTE: do NOT park in the bookstore lot - that is for shoppers only and is well-watched by security - tickets are \$50!). Enter any door, go down a 1/2 flight and then to the center door facing the inner campus. Piskor 10 (large smart classroom) is on the left by the door. Restrooms nearby.

Valentine 104 - Park in J lot far in from Park St. Walk up the hill with the black iron railing. Enter Flint Hall, walk through the corridor, out the door at the end and up the stairs. Turn left into Valentine Hall. 104 is on the right 4 doors down. Restrooms are across the hall, nearby.
