Fall 2017 SOAR Course Locations and Parking Info (updated: 08-04-17)

SUNY Potsdam – Campus Layout and Parking: www2.potsdam.edu/campusmap (provides a link to the university's interactive map showing building shapes, names and locations; use tab at top to link to the parking map)

LAYOUT NOTES: SUNY classroom buildings are largely situated in a square, with the Crumb Library sitting in the center of the quad. At each corner of the quad, you will find an open-arched walkway between the buildings. Maxcy Hall (sports complex) sits by itself with its own parking areas, just off Outer Main St. The SOAR office is in room 382 (on the third floor; just to the left when you exit the elevator) of Van Housen Extension. The University Police is directly below the SOAR office on the first floor.

PARKING NOTES: Please give yourself extra time for parking and walking to your SUNY classrooms. **Parking reminders:** 1) Write your plate # on the permit; 2) Park **ONLY** where visitor parking is permitted; 3) Always display your permit on your rearview mirror when on campus; 4) Your permit is valid through August 31, 2018.

SOAR Course Locations on the SUNY Potsdam Campus (NOTE: an * = a new SOAR location)

Barrington Student Union MPR (second floor, back side). Site of our end-of-semester luncheon (parking info coming later). Use the main entrance (which faces the statue of Minerva); go straight up the staircase (taking the left branch); to second floor; turn right at the corridor; and walk straight back to the **MPR** (multi-purpose room). To use the elevator: from the main entrance, take the right-hand hallway to the restrooms alcove; the elevator is just to the right of the "men's room" door; once upstairs, work your way back to the front of the building and cross over to the other corridor; turn right, then straight to the **MPR**. Restrooms are also near the entrance to the **MPR**.

Maxcy 104 and Maxcy Dance Studio. Park in lot #30 or #27 (NOT lot #29, the row closest to the building). To get to Room 104 (ground floor): after entering, bear right and go to far end of the corridor and turn left; 104 is the first room on the right. To get to the Dance Studio (on 3rd floor): after entering, bear right; take the first stairs on the left to 3rd floor (or use the elevator at far end of the corridor); as you head down the corridor, the Dance Studio is the first room on the right, overlooking the parking lot. Restrooms - use women's locker room opposite 104 or men's locker rooms near the entrance to the building; or walk past 104, go up the stairs and find regular restooms nearby.

Morey 117: Park in lot #1 (or #2). Walk to the Flagg/Morey corner of the quad and enter Morey Hall. Follow straight along the corridor (passing by restrooms), turn right at the end, and walk down to Morey 117 - the last room on the right. *Carson Hall is adjacent/attached to Morey Hall: follow the directions to Morey 117, but pass it by, and turn left. The next section of this complex, where there is and exit to the quad, is Carson Hall. Take the first staircase up to the second floor to find Carson 205*. One end of *Dunn Hall is across the street from Barrington, i.e. the end faces Minerva; the other end faces Brainerd. Enter either end, find the stairs and go up to the second floor to find *Dunn 208.

Satterlee 225. Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter the quad from the /Morey corner. Enter Flagg (on the right) and take the nearby staircase to the second floor; walk to the far end of the corridor and down a half-flight of steps into Satterlee, arriving into the history of SUNY Potsdam display area. Walk through the display area to the far side where you can either take the stairs or the elevator to the second floor. Continue down the second floor corridor, almost to the end (note the restrooms as you go by). Room **225** will be on your right, at the end of the last short corridor.

Stowell 211. Park in lots #1 or #2. Cross over the quad until you reach the statue of Minerva (opposite Barrington Union). Turn left to enter Stowell Hall. **Stowell 211** is the large tiered classroom on the right. **Timerman 131.** Timerman forms a corner arch with Stowell. Park in lot #2; walk thru the first arch (beside, around Merrit Hall and enter Timerman (on the left) at the archway. Once inside, turn left and go to the end of the corridor to the last room on the right. **Alternate path to Timerman 131:** Park in lot #6. Enter the far left door, pass by the janitor's room...to the next door-pass through the small storage room into **Timerman 131** Restrooms are in the middle of the "back door" long corridor.

Other Potsdam Locations:

Lehman Park, Drive down Pierrponte, traveling south on Rt.56 toward Hannawa Falls. The SUNY campus will be on your left. As you reach the end of campus, you will notice a small road ("Akwesasne Road") on the right. Turn right onto this road and park at the small parking lot near the river. Then walk to the meeting point.

Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (Mormon) Church, (21 Castle Drive - just off of Leroy St. at the far end of Castle Dr.) Drive completely around to park at the back door; you are then only steps away from the Multi-purpose room (MPR) on the right. Restrooms are across the hall.

Mayfield Apartments: Community Room, (22 Mayfield Drive - *just off May Road*). The community room is in the one-story office building in the center of the circular drive at the back of the complex. Park only where you see "**VISITOR**" (*marked on the curb*), or park in the lot beyond the circle. Restroom is adjacent to the room.

Potsdam Civic Center: Community Meeting Room, (2 Park Street). (The room is on the 2nd floor of the new addition at the back of the older Civic Center). Park behind the building complex or in any nearby public parking lot (e.g. find free parking sections across from, and behind, the theater). Do **NOT** park in the IGA lot! Enter at the back corner doorway, using the Police Station entrance; once in, turn right, go up a half-flight of stairs; turn left and go up another half-flight to the room. (There is a small **elevator** near the stairs. **NOTE:** Close the inner elevator door as well as the outer door to turn on the light inside.). Restrooms are directly below the meeting room.

United Methodist Church: Sanctuary, (26 Main Street). Park behind church (or in the lot off Union St., or across from theater); enter via the **handicap door** on the front, or the side door (by the manse); once inside, go up the half flight, the Sanctuary is on the Union St. side of the church. Restrooms: one beyond the social room, others downstairs.

Clarkson University: Clarkson Hall Therapy Department. Clarkson Hall is downtown (not up on the hill); it is just past "Old Main" (sandstone building). It is U-shaped, and sits well back off Main St.). Park on the street. Walk into the courtyard, veer left at the sign "Clarkson University Graduate Studies PT." Enter the breezeway, turn right to take the elevator to the second floor. Exit left, then right - walking into a large open work-out room, You have arrived.

Clarkson University: *Rowley 244 is on the hill campus. Use the main entrance, and park in the large lot by Cheel Campus Center (this may change if the presenter can get a lot that is closer) park in the row closest to the small clutch of dorms. Choose a path - either left or right around the dorms. Once you get around them, head for the path that leads to two large builings that are connected by a glass corridor between them. You are heading to Rowley...the one on the right, When you come to the side door of closest to you., enter, turn left to get to the front of the building... there you will find restrooms and stairs Take the stairs up to second floor (there is an elevator at the far end of the front of the building, but it is more walking) - once up the stairscase, turn right, then left, into the back corridor, Rowley 244 is about halfway down this corridar (which faces that clutch of small dorms.

Hospice and Palliative Care of St. Lawrence Valley. From Potsdam, Hospice is about half-way to Canton, on the right at 6805 Hyw 11. A receptionist will greet you at the door. The classroom is at the back of the building, straight down the corridor.

NON-Potsdam LOCATIONS: (NOTE: an * = a new SOAR location)

Canton Locations:

When Coming from Potsdam, **Everygreen Cemetery** is at the first Canton light, on the left, across from the car wash and across from the golf course. The entrance is at the very corner. There are a few parking spots at the cemetery, There are plenty of spots at the mall area across the street. Please be careful when walking across the very busy street.

BOCES (St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Educational Services Center): Conference Room (TBA) (40 W. Main St) (i.e. on the right, on Rt.68 heading towards Ogdensberg from downtown Canton). Park in the lot next to the building (the entrance to the lot is from Hammond Drive). Enter the building from the front main entrance and walk straight back through the wide open main lobby to the Conference. If you enter from the parking lot, work your way through the corridors to the lobby, then to the Conference Room.

Canton Free Library: The Paige Room, 8 Park St. (next to the post office). There is un-metered parking along the side of the park nearest the Presbyterian Church, and also further along the sides of Park St. itself, and behind the library (follow the roadway between the library and the post office. Once inside, take the stairs down to the Paige room, the large room just into the left corridor.

Partridge Knoll: Multi-Purpose Room, (30 Sullivan Dr.) This is a large complex, just off intersection of State St. and SH 310 (down the road from Canton schools). Park in front or on the side, but NOT on the lawn! The Multi-Purpose Room is nearest the far left front entrance door to the building.

SLCHA (St. Lawrence County Historical Society): **Silas Wright House**. (3 East Main Street, i.e. Rt.11). Governor Wright's white house with its across from old town park. The red barn addition, parking and main entrance are all at the back of the house. Use Canton Savings and Loan bank entrance on Court St. and park behind the SLCHA building. There's also free parking in the lot behind the nearby county building (entrance from Judson St.). Do <u>not</u> park in the Canton Savings and Loan spaces. Two restrooms near the entrance.

St. Lawrence-Lewis BOCES: Conference Room A (40 W. Main St.- *on the right, on Rt.68 heading towards Ogdensburg from downtown*). Park in the lot next to the building (the entrance to the lot is from Hammond Drive). Enter the building from the front main entrance and walk straight back through the wide open main lobby to Conference Room A. Restrooms are in a vestibule off the main lobby.

St. Lawrence University - SLU (Romoda Dr.): (NOTE: * = a new SOAR location)

NOTE: Do <u>NOT</u> park in marked reserved spots for *faculty/staff or visitor* - those all require an SLU pass. To avoid getting a ticket, park only in **lot J** (just beyond the science buildings); **lot D** (behind and on the far side of the sports complex - *no parking pass needed!!*) **NOTE:** entrance to **lots J and D** is off of Park St., or **lot H** next to Vilas Hall **NOTE:** use the formal entrance to SLU from Main St. to get to **lot D**. *Lot D is often full; but there may be handicap spots available in the row facing Griffiths and Noble Center*. The walk from **lot J** is uphill; the walk from **lots D and H** are more level. **NOTE: Always display your SOAR parking pass!** (SLU Security knows when we have classes on campus.)

Bewkes 232. (Second building from J lot with a 1/2 flight of outside stairs facing Park St.) Once inside, go up another 1/2 flight. Bewkes 232 is on the right, two doors down.

*Brown 144. From lot J, enter the back side of Flint Hall. Walk past the office rooms to the other end of the short corridor, and continue up the half-flight of stairs to the main floor. Turn right and go to the end of the hall to enter the Brown Hall section of the complex. Continue straight, past the first long (windowed) hallway on left, making a couple of short turns (around a corner of Bloomer Auditorium), and then left into the next long corridor. Brown 144 is in this corridor.

Johnson 013 & 307 Once parked in lot "J", walk up the hill on the path closest to Park St. Walk past Bewkes Hall and down into the circular drive that comes next. Johnson Hall is then ahead on the left. Enter at the far door (there's a covered open breezeway there that connects Johnson to Bewkes). Once in the building take the nearby elevator or stairway to the basement. Room **013** is on the right, almost at the end of the corridor. For **Johnson 307**, take the elevator up to the tAhird floor, work your way around until you find this small classroom.

The closest lot we can park in for *Richardson 201* and Atwood 202* is "H" lot (across from the theater, with ample spots for people with a handicap), Walk up the hill- Richardson is the building to the right of the chapel, and Atwood is to the right of Richardson. Once at the top of the hill, take the outside half-steps up that face Atwood; once inside, take a full set of stairs up one more - Richardson 201* is then on your left. For those going to Atwood, enter at the steps that face Richardson, cross the corridor and go up to the top floor. *Atwood 031 is on the left.

SUNY Canton

NOTE: Parking information, as well as photos, will be posted later on the SOAR website for these three new SUNY Canton and the other new ones as well

All three classes held there this semester are relatively close together at the top of the hill. Drive into the main entrance of SUNY Canton at the second stop light from HWY 68 after the downtown bridge. At the "Y" near the top of the hill, veer right. Pass by a "drive" that turns behind Neveldine Hall, and turn left at the next roadway onto Miller Rd. Drive all the way in to a smallish lot in front of Miller Campus Center (with several handicap places). If there are no spots available, find a space (not one reserved!) in the lots you just passed by, and walk back up to Miller. Enter the main door. Walk up to corridor, look right and see a dark door in a small alcove. It's the elevator. Take it to the second floor and then look for the Miller 218-220 on the right in about about half-way down the corridor on the right.. If you are headed for Payson Hall 219* keep walking. It attached to Miller by both an inner and an outer glass corridor. Stop and make a "U" turn to the right, down a few steps to a huge tiered auditorium. You have arrived at Payson 219*. If you are on your way to *Wicks 206...don't turn, just keep on walking, but use the glassed in corridor and exit out onto a cement plateau and you may become distracted by the very tall administrative/faculty office building, and miss the door to *Wicks. just beyond on the right is another elevator you can use. There are food courts, mail boxes, etc. on several levels.

REMINDER: Before starting out to where you are going to a new location, take a few minutes to look at that location site on the SOAR website... you'll get some visual images and a map, plus a few more details. It might save you some walking!
