## Spring 2015 SOAR Course Locations and Parking Info (update: 03-25-15)

SUNY Potsdam - Campus Layout and Parking: www2.potsdam.edu/campusmap (provides a link to the university's interactive map showing building shapes, names and locations; use tab at top to link to parking map). Your parking pass must be displayed every time you park on campus.

**SOAR Course Locations on the SUNY Potsdam Campus** (**NOTE:** \* = a new SOAR location)

Barrington Student Union MPR (second floor, back side). Site of our end-of-semester luncheon (parking info coming later). Use the main entrance (which faces the statue of Minerva); go straight up the staircase (taking the left branch) to second floor; turn right at the corridor; and walk straight back to the MPR (multi-purpose-room). To use the elevator: from the main entrance, take the right-hand hallway to the restrooms alcove; the elevator is just to the right of the "men's room" door; once upstairs, work your way back to the front of the building and cross over to the other corridor; turn right, then straight to the MPR.

\*Brainerd Hall 202 and Darkroom. Park in 1 or in lots near Van Housen Ext. From lot 1, enter the quad at the corner between Morey and Flagg; walk past Flagg and Satterlee - the first door past Satterlee is for the Brainerd Art Gallery. Enter there, walk past the gallery to the staircase (on the left). Go to the second floor: the first door on the right, through an alcove is where the darkroom is; Room 202 is a few doors down on the left.

Crane Music Center: Bishop 115 and Wakefield Recital Hall. To get to Bishop Hall, park in Lot #9 (enter from Barrigton Drive). Enter Bishop from either end of the building, walk to the center corridor. Turn down the center corridor, then move to the **left** corridor, (the staircase and elevator should be on your right as you start down this corridor). **Bishop 115** is large classroom a few doors down on the left (just past the short corridor on the left that leads to Snell Hall). For Wakefield Recital Hall, take the staircase or the elevator to the second floor. Wakefield is directly in front of you then. (Alternate path to Wakefield: Park by Hosmer Hall, walk up the left outside ramp, enter Bishop Hall - Wakefield is directly in front of you.)

Kellas Hall 217 (second floor, door to room faces lot #6). Park in lot #2 (or #6 behind the building). Enter at the corner archway door (from lot #6, enter the back door, turn right to enter Kellas). Take the stairs or elevator (in the Kellas vestibule near the back door) to the second floor; 217 ("distance learning") is around the corner, the first door on the left. WARNING! Please watch the single step when you enter or exit room the alcove for room 217!

Maxcy Hall 104 and Dance Studio. Park in lot #30 or #27 (NOT lot #29, the row closest to the building). To get to Maxcy 104 (ground floor): after entering, bear right and go to far end of the corridor and turn left; 104 is the first room on the right. To get to the Maxcy Dance Studio (on 3rd floor): after entering, bear right; take first stairs on the left to 3rd floor (or use the elevator at far end of the corridor); as you head down the upstairss corridor, the **Dance Studio** is the first room on the right, overlooking the parking lots.

Morey Hall 117 - English/Communication Conference Room. Park in lot #1. Enter Morey at the archway with Flagg. Follow the corridor straight, then right. Morey 117 is the last room (2 entrances) on the right...

## **Other Potsdam Locations:**

\*Canton-Potsdam Hospital Campus: Conference Room at 20 Cottage St. (NOTE: This building is the old nursing home which sits off by itself near the emergency end of the hospital building). Entrance to parking is from Cottage St. The **Conference Room** is on the third floor. An elevator is at the far end of the building.

The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints: Gym/Social Room (21 Castle Drive - just off of Leroy St. at the far end of Castle Dr.) NOTE: Go all the way around the church and park in the small lot by the back door; enter there - the gym/social room will be on the right after you enter, about half-way down the hall.

Clarkson University (http://www.clarkson.edu/about/map.html). CAMP (Center for Advanced Materials Processing) is a large building in the SW corner of the hilltop campus. Enter from the campus from the main entrance on Rt.11; park in the large lot at Cheel Arena and enter the back door. CAMP 175 is in the center/back corridor. Clarkson Hall PT Department is in a large U-shaped building (currently being renovated!) at 59 Main St. in downtown Potsdam. Park on the street or behind the building. The PT Dept. is on the second floor in the east end of the building. Use the elevator near the east door entrance.

\*Lehman Park (Potsdam) - Heading away from Potsdam on Pierrepont Ave, Lehman Park is on the right (just below Maxcy Hall, an extension from Canton Dr.), on the Raquette River, before the road curves to go to Hannawa Falls. Meet in Maxcy 104 first!

Mayfield Apartments: Community Room, (22 Mayfield Drive - just off May Road). The community room is in the one-story office building in center of the circular drive. Park only where you see "VISITOR" (marked on the curb) or in the lot beyond the circle. Enter the main door: the Community Room is on the left.

**Potsdam Civic Center: Community Meeting Room,** (2 Park Street). (The room is on the 2nd floor of the new addition at the back of the older Civic Center). Park behind the building complex or in any nearby public parking lot (e.g. find free parking sections across from, and behind, the theater. NOTE: do NOT park in the IGA lot!). Enter at the back of the complex, using the Police Station entrance; once inside turn right, go up a half-flight of stairs; turn left and go up another half-flight to the room. (There's a small **elevator** near the stairs. **NOTE:** Close the inner elevator door as well as the outer door to turn on the light inside.)

Potsdam Public Library: Computer Center - follow parking (and elevator) instructions above for the Civic Center. The Computer Center is in the basement of the library at the front of the building.

Potsdam Town Hall: Community Room, 18 Elm St. This is a new red brick building on the north side of Elm St., across from the IGA. There a small free parking lot behind the building; other public town lots are nearby, behind other buildings. Enter the building either by the front or back doors and follow the main corridor to the room (at the back of the building).

## **Canton Locations:** (NOTE: \* = a new SOAR location)

**Canton Public Library: Paige Room**, 8 Park St. The library is the white building next to the post office. Park free on the off-the-main-streets inner two sides of the park, or drive down the one-way alley between the library and the post office (or enter from Miner St.) to find free parking in the store plaza lot behind the library. Enter the front door and take the stairs (or the key-activated elevator) to the basement. The Paige Room is the first room on the left. (Unisex restroom is opposite.)

\*E. J. Noble Hospital Building: Betty Evans Room. (80 E. Main St.). Park in the main lot out front. Enter the main entrance on the left (admire the butterfly garden on your left as you enter) and take the staircase to second floor The Betty Evans Room is directly opposite the staircase. (NOTE: there is an elevator at the far end of the corridor, i.e. near the main entrance on the right; restrooms are near the main entrance)

**Partridge Knoll** (senior living facility): **Multi-Purpose Room**, 30 Sullivan Dr. This is a large complex, just off intersection of State St. and SH 310 (down the road from Canton schools). Park in front or on the side, but NOT on the lawn! The Multi-Purpose Room is nearest the far left front entrance door to the building. (Restrooms are in the center of the building near the office.)

\*First Presbyterian Church on the Park: Community Room (across from Silas Wright House). Park around the park. SLCHA (St. Lawrence County Historical Society): Silas Wright House, 3 East Main Street (Rts.11 and 68). SOAR classes are all held in the County Gallery in the Red Barn Addition (near the front desk, where you will also find two unisex restrooms). Governor Wright's white house with its white picket fence sits across from old town park. The red barn addition, parking and main entrance are all at the back of the house. Use Canton Savings and Loan bank entrance on Court St. to get to the parking lot behind the SLCHA building. Park behind in the small SLCHA lot. (NOTE: the lot by the bank is for bank parking. There is also free parking in the lot behind the nearby county building (entrance from Judson St.).

SLU (St. Lawrence University): From downtown Canton, take Park St. to the far edge of the SLU campus (science buildings on the left; sports buildings on the right). Parking Options at SLU: Option 1) Turn right (along the back side of the sports complex) into parking lot D (NOTE: the small lot facing Park St. is not part of Lot D; do not park there!) NOTE: you can park anywhere in lot D without a permit; however, you then will need to walk across Park St. (NOTE: only use the crosswalks!) to get to your SOAR classes. Option 2) Just past the science buildings, turn left into parking lot J (NOTE: if you miss that turn, use the entrance on the far side of the lot, off the service drive). You can park anywhere in lot J except in those spots marked for "Faculty/Staff" or "Visitor" (i.e. those spots closest to the science buildings; these spots are reserved for SLU issued parking pass holders). To avoid getting a ticket, when parking in lot J, hang your SUNY Potsdam parking pass on your review mirror. (NOTE: you may be ticketed if you park in any other lots, incluing the bookstore lot (the spots there are for bookstore customers only!).

To get to Johnson, Hepburn, Carnegie, Richardson, and Atwood Halls - from "L-shaped" lot H walk to the pedestrian plaza on the side of the sports complex facing the stadium. All these academic halls are on the other side of Park St. Cross at Park St. at any convenient cross walk. Crossing from the plaza near the stadium puts you directly in front of Johnson Hall (or cross at any of the other crosswalks to the main campus). From **lot J**, walk up the paved path closest to Park St and walk along Park. **Johnson Hall of Science** is the large modern building with a circular drive in front. Walk down the drive or nearby path. To get to \*Johnson 142, enter the building at the first (west wing) door; Johnson 142 is on the left, 3 doors back from the far end. To get to \*Johnson 309, continue down the walk to the second door (under breezeway that connects Bewkes Hall to Johnson Hall). Enter Johnson Hall (on the left) and turn right to enter the east wing; take the nearby **elevator** to the third floor; then walk all the way to the very end of the corridor. Johnson 309 is the very last room on the left. (Restrooms in Johnson Hall, on each floor, are all located in east corridors, near NE corner of the building.) There are cross walks all along Park street that lead to pathways taking you to an inner road - now a pedestrian-only walkway. The main entrances to Hepburn, Carnegie, Richardson Halls all face this pedestrianonly road, and **Atwood Hall** faces the car-road extension. Crossing Park St. at the bookstore, walk up to the pedestrian walkway, turn left, passing by Sykes dining hall and dorm to get to **Hepburn Hall** (which sits back behind a small circlular park area). Enter Hepburn and take the half-flight of stairs up to the main floor. \*Hepburn 112 is the first classroom on the left (restrooms are in the right corridor). Carnegie Hall is the classroom buildling next to Hepburn.. Enter the main door and take the half flight of stairs (or the elevator) to the basement. Carnegie 10 (theater) is opposite the elevator (restrooms are nearby). Passing by the chapel, the next classroom building is **Richardson Hall**.. Ascend the staircase that faces the chapel. Once inside, \*Richardson 104 is the second door on the right (ladies' room is opposite; men's rooms are on the floor above or below). Atwood Hall is the last building in this row of classroom buildings. Enter Atwood from the entrance facing Richardson Hall and descend the half flight to the basement. \*Atwood 3 is the large classroom on the left (restrooms are nearby).

**SUNY Canton: \*Halford Hall (CREST Center).** From downtown Canton, continue straight onto SH 68 (towards Ogdensburg). Turn into SUNY Canton at the last stop light and go up the hill. At the intersection, bear right, passing by the water tower and a large low building (Cooper Service Complex); Halford Hall is the next (new small) building. Park in lot 11, next to Halford Hall.

## **OTHER Location:**

**Indian Creek Nature Center** (*Rensselaer Falls*) - Take Hwy 68 from Canton (towards Ogdensburg) for about 3-4 miles to CR14 (it "T's" with Hwy 68). Turn left and head towards Rensselaer Falls. Indian Creek Nature Center will be on your left in 3.4 miles (the entrance is marked with a large sign).
